Family Music for Toddlers is a parent/child class designed to bring God's gift of joyful music and movement to toddlers. Activities include singing, dancing, creative movement, focused listening, melodic and rhythmic echoing and simple rhythm instrument playing; creating an environment where the child's musical aptitude is nurtured and skills are developed.
